

The DSPLICINF command displays a number of system unique values for the IBM System i computer. These values are often used by 3rd party vendors for tiered pricing and licensing of their software.

Here is a sample output:

```
===> DSPLICINF
System serial number: S10ABCDE
Processor group:      P05
Model type:          9406
Model number:        520
Feature code:        7350
OS Version:          V05R04M00
LPAR number:         001
```

To install DSPLICINF command on your iSeries you'll need to restore a command and a program object contained in the DSPLICINF.SAVF save file. Here are the restore instructions:

- 1) download DSPLICINF.SAVF to a well known folder on your PC i.e. (C:\Centerfield)
- 2) start MS-DOS command prompt (i.e. click on Start->Run->cmd->OK)
- 3) navigate to the folder where save file is located (i.e. CD C:\Centerfield)
- 4) ftp <your iSeries machine name>
- 5) <your iSeries user profile>
- 6) <your iSeries password>
- 7) binary
- 8) quote rcmd CRTSAVF QGPL/DSPLICINF
- 9) put dsplicinf.savf /qsys.lib/qgpl.lib/dsplicinf.file
- 10) quit
- 11) exit
- 12) sign on to a green-screen emulator session for your iSeries
- 13) RSTOBJ OBJ(DSPLICINF) SAVLIB(QGPL) DEV(\*SAVF) OBJTYPE(\*CMD \*PGM) SAVF(QGPL/DSPLICINF)
- 14) invoke CALL QCMD to be able to do a screen capture
- 15) invoke DSPLICINF to display information to generate License Key

NOTE: Command is restorable back to V5R2 version of the operating system.

To ship the data DSPLICINF output to your 3rd party vendor, you can simply copy/paste screen's text to an email or screen capture it via Alt->PrintScreen key combination.
